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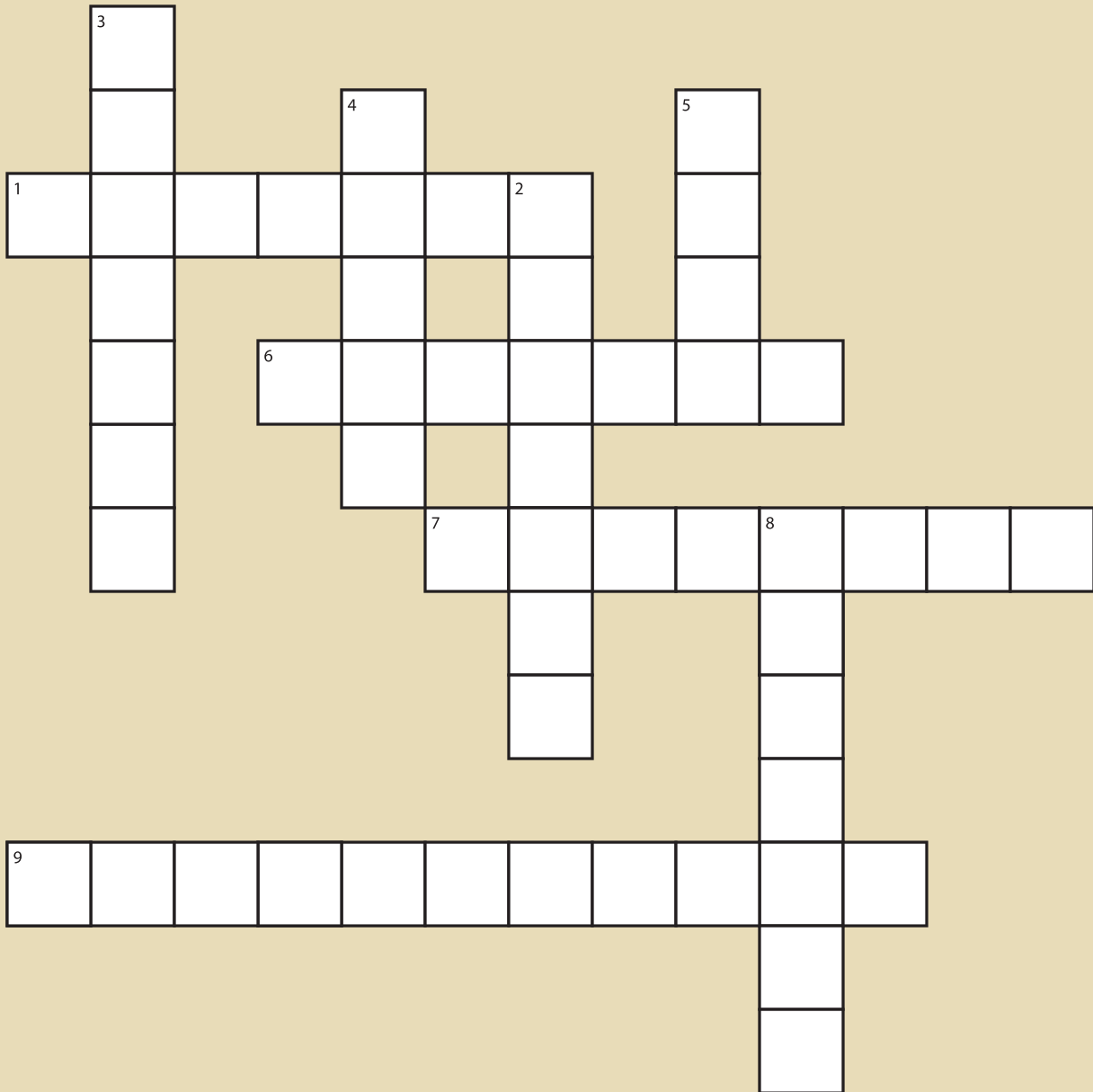

to the River Yare! Yarr harrghh!

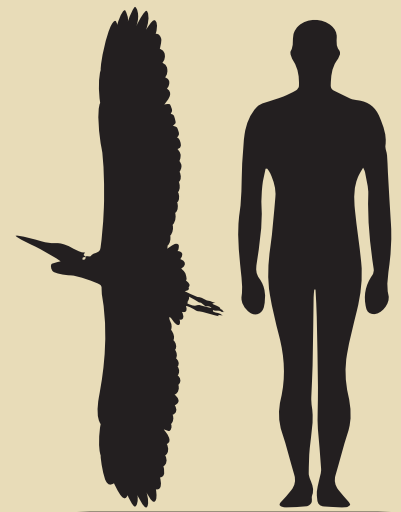
The Broads are made up of over

or roughly the same as the  
straight-line distance between  
Norwich and Oxford!



The Broads are sometimes wrongly  
referred to as 'The Norfolk Broads'.  
The reason this is wrong is because  
part of it (River Waveney) extends  
into Suffolk.

The Broads contains the highest  
concentration of medieval churches  
in the world!

The Grey Heron is huge! It can  
grow to around 1m tall and have a  
wingspan of almost 2m!

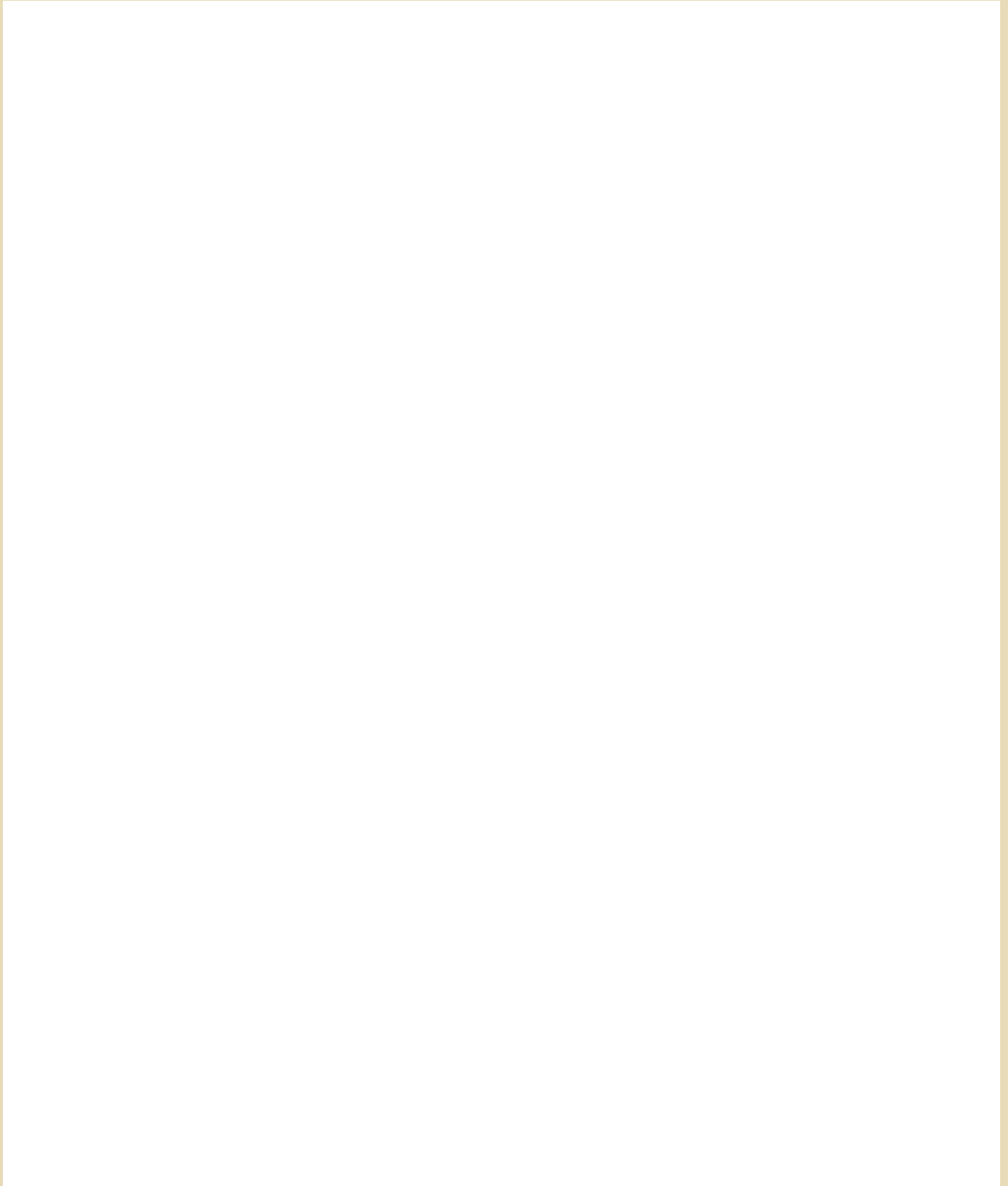
